On Saturday, August 13 2022, under the management of OCS NDMO, a team consisting mainly of volunteers started assembling the home care packages that will be distributed to households in Majuro, Kwajalein and neighboring islands, especially those with confirmed cases. In partnership with MALGOV and Iroij Yolan Jurelang (as contact point for Alabs on Majuro), the first 900 boxes were able to make their way to Ajeltake to Laura yesterday evening.

The home care package contents are donations from within RMI and abroad, and consists of masks, hand sanitizers and hand soaps to help the community cope with the COVID-19 outbreak. A press release will follow to list out the generous countries and governments, organizations, and individuals that kindly donated these for the people of RMI.

Over the past weekend the team grew with more and more volunteers coming into the International Conference Center in Delap (ICC) to lend a helping hand from time to time. Volunteers have included representatives from Nito Butterfly Foundation, COOPS's MadDogs, Majuro Senator Steven Phillip, EPA, WUTMI, MalGov, and various individuals.



The Office of the Chief Secretary takes this time to thank all those who have helped in this operation since the start. This is a very big operation and those who wish to volunteer their time can go to ICC between 10am and 5pm throughout this week.

Urging the public to take note that the RMI borders are still closed but, with the community spread of the COVID-19 virus, there is no need for the 10 days strict quarantine period.
