ENGLISH:

As COVID-19 is now in the Majuro and Ebeye Communities, protocols to restrict travel to the neighboring islands, including Arno Atoll have now been implemented.

During the NDC meeting today 9 August 2022, the committee approved recommendations to temporarily halt all Majuro outbound travel to the neighboring islands as the MOHHS targets their response in the Majuro and Ebeye Communities. These restrictions are aimed at protecting the neighboring islands and its people from the impacts of the virus.

With this, essential good delivery of cargo and supplies will be permitted upon request and approval from the NDC via request letter or email. Protocols for essential drop off by air or sea will be established for adherence by all crew.

Process for Request of Cargo Drop in Neighboring Islands

Response time is at 2-3 working days.
