Special Envoy Yun announced that the third round of negotiations will be held in the Marshall Islands at the end of October or early November. Special Envoy Yun commended President Kabua on his statement during the 77th United Nations General Assembly stating that it was a very well balanced statement and that the nuclear issue was well timed amidst the Ukraine-Russian war. After the courtesy, Special Envoy Yun toured the Embassy and was shown photos of the nuclear legacy that hung on the walls of the Embassy.
