His Excellency David Kabua departed New York for Arkansas and was greeted by the marshallese community at the airport arrival hall. The sound of ukulele and the melody of the marshallese welcome song protruding through the arrival hall, onlookers seemed pleased and felt welcomed too.

This is the first time President Kabua visited the marshallese community in Arkansas since the pandemic began 2 years ago.
