Cabinet Decisions 2024 - 080-104 April 18, 2024 Majuro, Marshall Islands [English Version]

Cabinet Decisions

On April 2, 2024, the Cabinet made the following 5 decisions:

- 1. ...Approved the publication of Debt Bulletins by the Ministry of Finance twice a year which includes the level public and publicly guaranteed (PPG) debt actual (including 5 years historical data), with breakdown by (i) domestic and external debt, (ii) creator, (iii) government guarantees, and (iv) debt forecast covering 3 years.
- 2. ...Approved the recommendation to raise the minimum wage from \$3.00 per hour to \$4.00 per hour by October 1, 2024, with an annual incremental increase by October 1, 2027 to a minimum wage of \$5.25;
 - a. Oct. 1, 2024 increase from \$3.00 to \$4.00;
 - b. Oct. 1, 2025 increase to \$4.50
 - c. Oct, 1, 2026 increase to \$5.00
 - d. Oct. 1, 2027 increase to \$5.25
- 3. ...Authorized the creation of a Task Force to establish the Universal Basic Income guidelines and operating mechanisms:
 - a. MISSA Bryant Edejer as member;
 - b. Health Secretary Francyne Wase-Jacklick as member;
 - c. Education Sallyann deBrum;
 - d. Finance Secretary of Finance or designee;
 - e. Private Sector Chamber of Commerce Sherwood Tibon as Chairperson;
 - f. Civil Society Brenda Alik as member;
 - g. Kwajalein Atoll Tony Maika as member;
 - h. 4 Atolls Bujen Lelwoj as member;
 - i. MIMA Mayor Riming Ring as member
- 4. ...Approved the Resolution Conveying the Condolence and Gratitude of the People GRMI to the family and friends of Late Minister, Senator, Ambassador, Secretary Iroij Jiba Boklon Kabua.

5. ...Re-appointed Ms. Kino S. Kabua to continue as the Chief Secretary.

On April 4, 2024, the Cabinet made the following 3 decisions:

- 1. ...Extended for another term of four (4) years the appointment for the current Retail Price Monitoring Board Members:
 - a. Director of EPPSO, Chairperson;
 - b. Secretary of Culture & Internal Affairs;
 - c. Secretary of Finance, Banking & Postal Services;
 - d. Edward Fowler, representing Big Businesses;
 - e. Valentine Myazoe, representing Small Businesses;
 - f. Robin Kios, representing Marshall Islands Shipping Corporation; and appointed Rairok Councilwoman Miyoko Kramer, representing the largest local Government and the interest of women and youth, for a term of four years.
- 2. ...Approved the request from the Ministry of Health & Human Services (MOHHS) to establish three (3) positions under the CDC Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity (ELC) Grant: One (1) Finance Specialist position, One (1) Health Associated Infection/Antibiotic Resistance (HAI/AR) Director, and One (1) HAI/AR Coordinator.
- 3. ...Approved the creation of a high-level Presidential Envoy (PE)/Champion to assist the President's Office in carrying out its Agenda: Ministry of Health & Human Services PE/Champion for Primary Health Care and Disease Prevention.

On April 10, 2024, the Cabinet appointed Jendrikdrik Paul to be a Public Service Commissioner and authorized the Minister In Assistance to the President and Environment to introduce the resolution to the Nitijela.

On April 11, 2024, the Cabinet made the following 2 decisions:

- 1. ...Approved the National Invasive Species Strategy and Action Plan (NISSAP.) (To obtain a copy please contact the Ministry of Natural Resources and Commerce.)
- 2. ...Approved Eugene Muller to replace Rose Murphy as Deputy Chairperson to the Marshall Islands Development Bank (MIDB) Board of Directors.
