**Cabinet Decisions**

On Thursday January 30, 2025, the Cabinet approved the establishment of the Taskforce on Substance as follows:

- a. Commissioner of the Marshall Islands Police Department (MIPD) as Chairperson
- b. Attorney General as Vice Chairperson;
- c. Secretary of Health and Human Services;
- d. Commissioner of the Public School System;
- e. Postmaster General;
- f. Chief of Customs;
- g. Sheriff, Majuro Atoll Local Government;
- h. Director of Immigration;
- i. Director of Ports Authority;
- j. National Security Office Director; and
- k. Dr. Holden Nena.

The Taskforce on Substance is responsible for coordinating the enforcement of existing substance-related legislation, reviewing and recommending improvements or new laws, and strategizing ways to raise awareness among students, parents, and communities about the dangers of substance abuse. They also facilitate data-sharing, assess treatment programs and facilities, establish benchmarks, and report progress to the Cabinet, while carrying out any other tasks assigned by the Cabinet.

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
